Extension Staff,

As many of you are aware, swine returning from an exhibition to its home herd or moved to a purchaser's herd, following an exhibition or consignment sale, must be isolated and retested negative for pseudorabies not less than 30 days and not more than 60 days after reaching the swine's destination. (Code of Iowa 166D.13(2))

Therefore, the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship, in cooperation with the Iowa 4-H program, and the Iowa FFA program are requesting counties with a non-terminal swine show to provide to us the following information.

This information must be sent within two days of the completion of your swine show.

1. County Name
2. Dates of Exhibition
3. Producer Name, Complete Address, Phone
4. Number of swine leaving the exhibition.
5. Id of the animal(s) leaving the exhibition – this should be the 4-H ear tag number or ear notches.
6. Destination of the pigs leaving the exhibition.
7. Extension Staff Initials
8. Exhibitor and Parent/Guardian Signature

This information must be sent within two days of the completion of your county fair swine show.
