



## 4-H Livestock Advisory Committees

The state 4-H office currently has four active livestock advisory committees, one each for horse, beef, sheep and swine. The beef, sheep, and swine advisory committees have focused on the Iowa State Fair 4-H show, rule changes, and show management. The committees traditionally meet once a year, usually in the fall, although occasionally will have a spring meeting. The meetings are held in Ames. The horse advisory committee meets four times per year, and focuses on all horse events and activities, including horse jamboree, leader training, judging contest, and more. In addition to advising on state fair changes, they are very active in implementing other horse events.

New members who are interested in making a difference are needed on all of the committees. County staff are encouraged to nominate youth and adults who might be interested in participating in one of these advisory programs. Nominations should be sent to the State 4-H Office by September 1. Staff will be contacted for reference checks, and selection.
