



Iowa 4-H Re-tagging Procedure For animals eligible for the Iowa State Fair

Beef, Sheep and Meat Goats

1. Retag the animal and record both the old tag number and new tag number
2. Send notice and pertinent information, Exhibitor name, old tag number, new tag number, and any other pertinent information to State 4-H Office, Attn. Mike Anderson, Extension 4-H Bldg., Ames, IA 50011-3630.
3. The State 4-H office will make the change on the verification form.
4. All re-tagged animals will be scanned during check-in at the Iowa State Fair

Swine

1. Contact Mike Anderson at the State 4-H Office on all swine retagging.
2. Send notice in writing or email to the State 4-H Office including, exhibitor name, lost tag number, ear notches, and any other pertinent information. Be sure the ear notches are read correctly and match both the animal and what was written on the verification form
3. A State Fair swine committee member will either retag the animal or it will be noted to replace the tag upon arrival at the State Fair and be DNA tested.

Staff, Superintendent or trained committee members must do all retagging.
