

Iowa 4-H Scholarship Listing for Fall 2010

- The following is a complete listing of Iowa 4-H scholarships available to **Iowa 4-H'ers** entering college or continuing their college education in the fall of 2010.
- Information on the Hills Bank Leadership Grant (juniors in high school) is included.
- Applicants must enroll as a full-time student (minimum of 12 credit hours) to receive any scholarship award.
- Scholarships and amounts awarded are contingent on continued funding by award donors.
- Unless otherwise stated, scholarship recipients will forfeit their award if they make changes to schools or majors that are not included in the scholarship criteria.

The following items are required to complete all 4-H scholarship applications for fall 2010.

1. **Transmittal Form:** *Iowa 4-H College Scholarship Transmittal form, VI-2028-SAS attached to the front of your application* (CHECK SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY CAREFULLY, especially major and selected counties by reviewing criteria listed below. **ISU** = Iowa State University.)
2. **Application:** **Current high school seniors use** *4-H Scholarship Application, VI-950903-SAS, 4 pages.* **Current college students use** *4-H College Scholarship Application, VI-000901-SAS, 4 pages.* **High school junior applicants** use Hills Bank Leadership Grant special application.
3. **Transcripts:** Current/complete high school* or college transcript, including fall 2009 (fall '09 grades may be copy of grade report). *If taking college courses while in high school, attach grade report(s) or transcript(s) of courses.
4. **Letters of Recommendation:** **Two** letters of recommendation, **one** from an academic advisor or teacher, and **one** from Extension staff or adult 4-H volunteer. Letters should attest to scholastic ability, 4-H participation and leadership, financial need, and character of the applicant.

Application, transmittal form, transcript(s)/grade report, letters of recommendation must be **RECEIVED** before or on February 1, 2010 (with the exception of the 2010 Lloyd 4-H Scholarships).
