2. Completed and signed *4-H College Scholarship Application*, VI-000901-SAS, 4 pages, **for use by current college students**.
3. Current, complete grade transcript(s), **including Fall 2009** (fall '09 grades may be a copy of student grade report). (ISU students may submit the Access Plus transcript—add your name.)
4. **Two** letters of recommendation, **one** from an academic advisor or teacher and **one** from Extension staff or adult 4-H volunteer attesting to scholastic ability, 4-H or college participation and leadership, financial need, and character of the applicant.

Application should include information to verify eligibility. Applicant may receive only one Iowa 4-H Scholarship per year.

- FAX copies of the application will **NOT** be accepted.
- **DO NOT ATTACH ADDITIONAL PAGES OR REDUCE TYPE SIZE SMALLER THAN 10 POINT FONT** (application is four/4 pages).
