

Hills Bank and Trust Company Leadership Grant Summary

- Hills Bank and Trust Company Leadership Grants are available to high school JUNIORS residing in or attending schools in Benton, Cedar, Iowa, Johnson, Jones, Keokuk, Linn, Louisa, Muscatine, or Washington counties in Iowa.
- Hills Bank and Trust Company employees and their children are not eligible.
- Grants are available to students attending any of Iowa's accredited colleges, universities, or community colleges.
- Each grant will total \$2,000 with \$500 to be paid each semester of the qualifying recipient's first two years of college.
- Applicants will be evaluated on their involvement in Community Service and Student Group Activities, Work Experience and their High School Academic Information, which includes a grade point average of 2.8 or higher.
- The recipients of this grant, applying during their junior year of high school, will agree to attend a minimum of nine hours of Hills Bank® sponsored Leadership Training during their senior year.
- Each applicant will need to:
 - 1) complete the Hills Bank and Trust Company Leadership Grant Application,
 - 2) provide a copy of their most current, complete high school grade transcript including a fall 2009 grade report, and
 - 3) TWO signed letters of recommendation—**one** from a community member, employer, or volunteer **AND one** from a school teacher or academic advisor.

Helpful Hints

1. Be sure to complete all information requested
2. Utilize the space available, but you may add additional pages to complete application questions.
3. Include ACT and/or SAT scores on page 2. (Explain if not available.)
4. Complete the Student Group Activities, Community Service, and Work Experience. Include all appropriate activities.
5. Financial assistance, page 2 — Include sources such as parents, employment, other scholarships, financial aid, etc.
6. Leadership Comments, page 3 — This is where you tie it all together and expand on the activities listed in earlier sections. Tell how you were a leader for or gave leadership to the activities you listed.
7. Be sure to obtain ALL necessary signatures — Parent/Guardian, page 1 and High School Principal and High School Guidance Counselor, page 2.
8. Attach or have your school send a copy of your current, complete transcript including fall 2009 semester grades. If your fall 2009 grades are not included on your transcript, you may include a copy of your fall 2009 grade report you received.
9. Two signed Letters of Recommendation — confide in those who write recommendations for you specific information that will help them more effectively support your leadership grant application.
10. Give a copy of the Instructions for Letter of Recommendation to ONE academic advisor such as a high school instructor, guidance counselor, advisor, or principal **AND** ONE community member or volunteer.

 - Must be a high school junior who lives in or attends school in one of these ten counties: Benton, Cedar, Iowa, Johnson, Jones, Keokuk, Linn, Louisa, Muscatine, Washington
 - GPA of 2.8 or above
 - Demonstrated leadership, entrepreneurship, or community service related qualities
