2009 State Match Rules Muzzleloader

To participate in the Muzzleloader discipline, youth must be at least 12 years old. In order to compete within this discipline, youth must have completed all lessons in the Muzzleloader curriculum and have been a member of a 4-H Shooting Sports Club for at least a year. Muzzleloader competition is open to youth who are 12 years old as of January 1 of the current year.

25 YARD NOVELTY – Bottles Target: NMLRA Bottle Target (TG2427)

Distance: 25 yards

Course of Fire: 10 record shots on each target, 2 per bull, (20 record shots)

Time Limit: 48 minutes total running time.

Projectile: Patched soft lead round ball only.

Scoring: **Bottles:** as outlined on the target. Completely within neck-10 pts; nicking the neck-7 pts; within body-5 pts; nicking the body -3 pts.

All questions and rulings will be the responsibility of the match director and designated match personnel.
