1. Attach completed **Transmittal Form** to the front of your application. CHECK SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY CAREFULLY.
2. Completed and signed *4-H Scholarship Application*, VI-950903-SAS, 5 pages, **for use by current high school seniors.**
3. Current, complete grade transcript(s), **including Fall 2011** (fall '11 grades may be a copy of student grade report).
4. **Two** letters of recommendation, **one** from an academic advisor or teacher and **one** from Extension staff or adult 4-H volunteer attesting to scholastic ability, 4-H participation and leadership, financial need, and character of the applicant.

Application should include information to verify eligibility. Applicant may receive only one Iowa 4-H Scholarship per year.

- FAX copies of the application will **NOT** be accepted.
- **DO NOT ATTACH ADDITIONAL PAGES OR REDUCE TYPE SIZE SMALLER THAN 10 POINT FONT**
- Application is five pages, plus Transmittal Form, transcript/grade report, and two recommendation letters.
