Week 1: June 7-11, \$140

Oopy Goopy

Get ready for a wacky week of icky, sticky experiments and silly, slippery concoctions you create and take home. This isn't for the lighthearted; wear clothes you can get dirty! We're getting geared up for the Toy Story 3 movie release this week! Build rockets with Buzz Lightyear, go on a mission with Sergeant and the troops, have western day with Woody and Jessie, do crafts with Mr. and Mrs. Potato Head, nature hike with Rex and Hamm, and much more fun.

Week 8: July 26-30, \$140

Seussville

Oh, the places we will go with Dr. Seuss this week! We'll have visits from The Lorax, The Cat in the Hat, Yertle the Turtle, Sam I Am, and Horton. Our games, snacks, and activities will all be based upon Seuss books, rhymes, and adventures!

Week 3: June 21-25, \$140

Race around the World

No passport needed for this trip. Race to new and exciting locations each day to learn unique customs, crafts, foods, songs, games, dances, and animals from exciting countries. Meet our 4-H Center international staff members to learn about their country's culture.

Week 9: August 2-6, \$140

Day Camp Rewind

Spend the week revisiting all of our favorite activities and games as we put the entire summer on rewind! Get a chance to climb the tower, creek walk, make slime, water balloon catapult, visit the wetland animals, and spend time with International camp staff one more time. It's the best of day camp 2010!

Week 4: June 28-July 1 (short), \$130

Wetland Wonders

Wet places are wonderful areas to explore in the summer! We will visit the camp pond, creeks, river, and wetland areas to learn about all kinds of creatures like frogs, dragonflies, fish, beavers, and turtles. We'll also cool off with water games by the pool each day.

Week 5: July 6-9 (short), \$130

High Flying Adventure

This week we will spend four days trying out the climbing tower, bouldering wall, high ropes course, and zip lines. Learn the importance of harnesses, helmets, rope knots, and helping spot for your teammates. By Thursday you'll be able to climb like a monkey or zip through the air like your favorite superhero!

Day Camp Plus, \$40

Week 2+ June 18-19, Week 5+ July 9-10, Week 7+ July 23-24

If you don't want your week of day camp to end, we have three weeks you can sign up to spend the night at camp on Friday after day camp has ended. You'll have dinner at camp, a night swim, a campfire program with s'mores, and you'll spend the night in a camp cabin with other day campers and staff. Saturday morning you'll have breakfast, play games, and greet your parents at the 10:00 a.m. all-camp closing ceremony. This summer Day Camp Plus is offered for day campers of all ages.

Week 6: July 12-16, \$140

Castles & Dragons

Visit the medieval era. Make your own shield and coat of arms. Turn the day camp lodge into a spectacular castle with a dragon to guard your treasures. Search for the hidden troll along the nature trail. Try the water balloon catapult. Have a peasant's feast on Friday with turkey legs and bug juice brew.

Day Camp Participation Agreement:

I grant permission for my camper to participate in all planned camp activities such as, but not limited to: archery, swimming, high ropes, climbing, out-of-camp field trips by van or bus, and hiking. I understand that reasonable measures will be taken to safeguard the health and safety of my camper but cannot be insured or guaranteed that campers, equipment, premises, and/or activities will be free of hazards, accidents, and/or injuries. I understand that I will be notified as soon as possible in case of an emergency. In the event I cannot be reached in an emergency, I hereby authorize the Iowa 4-H Center to obtain medical attention for my camper, at my expense, and to provide whatever emergency medical, dental, or surgical treatment is necessary. As my child is a day camp participant, he/she will not attend if not feeling well. I understand that in order to provide a safe and cooperative group experience, my child may be dismissed from the program for reasons including behavior, illness/injury, or extreme homesickness. I will assume responsibility for transportation to and from the Iowa 4-H Center.

I understand the Iowa 4-H Center is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal articles. I authorize The Iowa 4-H Center and Iowa State University Extension to use any photographs, video, or written statements from my child's experience in public relations and marketing materials including Internet without compensation. If my child has any special needs, including a special diet or disability, I will contact the Iowa 4-H Center at least one week before the program or event(s). I understand I must submit a complete health form and balance of fees a week prior to the camp session. I understand camp fees are for the entire week of the session and are only refundable with a signed doctor's note due to illness. I understand I will receive a Day Camp Parent Packet with additional information following registration. I understand the \$30 deposit per camper per week is not refundable and not transferable under any circumstances.

I understand that although the Iowa 4-H Center has taken reasonable steps to provide my child with appropriate training, equipment, and skilled staff for his/her camp experience, I acknowledge that some inherent risks cannot be eliminated without destroying the unique character of the nt, to abide by all rules, to listen, and to follow all instructions given by activity leaders. In the event of an unforeseen or reasonably unpredictable circumstance, by my camper's voluntary participation in an activity, I am aware of and have acknowledged the existence of a risk and I clearly share in its assumption. I individually and corporately agree to hold harmless Iowa State University, ISU Extension, the Iowa 4-H Foundation, the Iowa 4-H Center, its volunteers, agents, employees, and officers irrespective of any negligent act or omission by the 4-H Center and/or those individuals arising from or related in any way to Iowa State University and the Iowa 4-H camping program.

Deposit: A \$30 non-refundable and non-transferable deposit per week is required to hold your spot. Deposits are applied to the total fee. Limited space is available. We will start a waiting list when weeks fill up.

Discounts:

- Youth registering for more than one week will receive a \$10 discount for **each** additional week.
- 4-H Club or Clover Kid Members take a \$10 discount per week

Location: The Iowa 4-H Center is located in Boone County, northwest of Madrid off County Road E57 and south on Peach Avenue. We are located next to the Iowa Arboretum.

Open House: Join us Thursday, June 3 anytime between 5:30 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. for a BBQ picnic dinner. You can try out the climbing tower and archery range, make a camp craft, take a wagon tour of camp, visit the overnight camp cabins and day camp lodge, and meet camp staff and directors. Parents will have the opportunity to ask questions about camp. Bring a friend, it's free!

Pick-Up & Drop-Off: We serve the communities of Ames, Boone, Madrid, and Ankeny, picking up day campers each morning between 7:15-7:45 a.m. and dropping them off in the afternoon between 4:45-5:30 p.m. ISU vans will route between Brookside Park in Ames, the Herman Park Pavilion in Boone, North Creek Park in Ankeny, and Edgewood Park in Madrid. Direct drop-off and pick-up of your day camper at the Iowa 4-H Center is available with permission from our camp secretary, Chris Peterson.

Parent Packets: Once we receive your registration, a Parent Packet will be sent to you in March including: specific pick up/drop off times, health forms, and general camp information.

Staff: Iowa 4-H Center Day Camp Staff are college-aged Iowa State University employees. They have gone through background checks, CPR & FA certifications, and two weeks of training in order to provide a fun and safe experience for all Day Campers.
