“Taking the Road Less Traveled: A Career Conference for Girls”

We are excited to announce the fall 2006 career conferences, “*Taking the Road Less Traveled.*” Sponsored by Iowa State University's Program for Women in Science and Engineering, the conferences goal is to expose females in sixth through twelfth grades, to career paths within science, technology, engineering and math. Approximately 2,500 individuals participate in this program each year. In the morning participants hear from professional women; in the afternoon they participate in hands-on activities or tours. Cost for the day is \$15 per participant (students, educators, parents, and chaperones) and includes lunch.

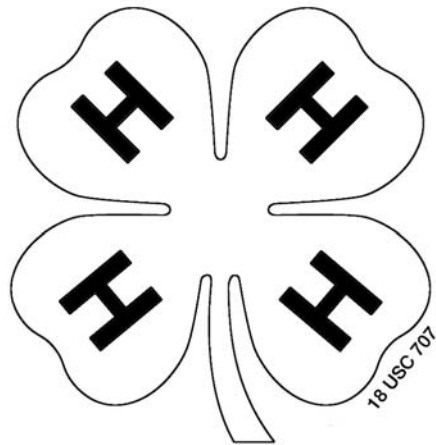
