

4-H Clubs of Excellence

Core Objectives – Must Complete 7 of 7

- ___ 1. Each 4-H member gave a presentation or held some leadership roll at a club meeting during the year. (talk, demonstration, report, panel discussions, lead pledge, lead recreation, etc.) This is for clubs under 30 4-H members, clubs over 30 – 60% of the members or 30 people – which ever is greater.
- ___ 2. 4-H Leaders attend two 4-H Leader Meetings (make up opportunities will be available)
- ___ 3. Club keeps a treasurer's book and submits it to the Extension Office by October 1
- ___ 4. Club keeps a secretary's book and submits to the Extension Office by October 1
- ___ 5. 4-H Leaders turn in necessary enrollment forms, health forms, program and / or project information in time.
- ___ 6. 4-H Club held 9 meetings throughout the year
- ___ 7. Have FUN growing with 4-H

Club Organization (Must complete 10 of the next 16)

- ___ 1. 4-H Club enrollment increases 3%, minimum of 1, which ever is greater.
- ___ 2. The 4-H club has one Organizational Leader and at least one Assistant or Project Leader enrolled
- ___ 3. 4-H Club elects and installs officers and has them perform duties of their respective office
- ___ 4. 4 out of the 6 club officers participate in countywide 4-H officers training
- ___ 5. 4-H Club keeps a yearly historian's book

Club Program

- ___ 6. Each 4-H member, 4-H leader and the Extension Office has a copy of a planned yearly program by Dec. 1st deadline
- ___ 7. 4-H Club conducted a local achievement show, club tour, educational tour or workshop
- ___ 8. 4-H Club held one or more family activities
- ___ 9. Every 4-H member served as host, hostess, or on a committee. This is for clubs under 30 members, clubs over 30 – 60% of members or 30 people – which ever is greater

Club Participation in County 4-H Activities and Events

- ___ 10. 90% or more of 4-H members exhibited at the county fair, club tour, or achievement show
- ___ 11. 50% or more of 4-H members participated in Educational Presentations, Working Exhibit, Share the Fun, Fashion Revue or Clothing Selection Contest
- ___ 12. At least one 4-H club member attended a 4-H camp, State 4-H Conference or other conference
- ___ 13. 70% of 4-H club members attended Awards Program
- ___ 14. 80% of 4-H club members participate in fair set up and/or clean up

Service to Others and Public Relations

- ___ 15. 4-H Club completed one or more community service projects throughout the year
- ___ 16. 4-H Club helped acquaint the public with 4-H (4-H display, float, posters in schools or businesses, program for community, etc.)
