

## Frequently Asked Questions

I'm worried we are going to miss a deadline. What do I need to know?

It might seem like there are lots of 4-H deadlines, but there really aren't. If you read your [Scott Scoop](#) every month, you will get all the information you need to know. Here are some of the dates you need to remember:

December 1<sup>st</sup>: ALL 4-Hers re-enrolling for the current year AND NEW 4-Hers planning to show at fair, MUST complete the following and return it to the Extension Office by 4:30 p.m.(NO LATES OR POSTMARKS WILL BE ACCEPTED) [Enrollment/Re-enrollment Form, Code of Ethics, Medical Release/Information Form, and Development Fee.](#)

September 30<sup>th</sup>: [Record books](#) and applications for [county awards](#) are due on this date.

December: Market Beef weigh-in is held in December. Watch your mail for details.

May 15<sup>th</sup>:\* This is the last day a NEW 4-Her who does NOT want to exhibit at fair will have to enroll in 4-H. The following is due by 4:30 p.m. (NO LATES OR POSTMARKS WILL BE ACCEPTED): [Enrollment Form, Code of Ethics, Medical Information/Release Form, and Development Fee.](#)  
If you are planning to bring livestock to the fair, this is the last date you have to complete [livestock identification forms](#). All animals EXCEPT poultry and rabbits need to be identified by May 15<sup>th</sup> by 4:30 p.m. (NO LATES OR POSTMARKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.)

July 1<sup>st</sup>:\* If you plan to exhibit livestock at the fair, you must sign up for the classes in which you intend to show by this date by 4:30 p.m. (NO LATES OR POSTMARKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.) This [form](#) is ONLY for livestock. You do not need to complete an entry form for any classes except livestock.  
If you plan to participate in [Fashion Revue](#) or [Clothing Selection](#), registration by this date is appreciated.  
If you plan to participate in [Communications](#) (Educational Presentations, Working Exhibits, Extemporaneous Speaking, or Share the Fun), registration by this date is appreciated.

There may be other deadlines during the year, such as registration for 4-H Family Fun Night and the 4-H Basketball Tournament. Please refer the Calendar topic for more information.

*\*If deadline date falls on a weekend the deadline date is usually extended to the following Monday. Please refer to Scott Scoop for exact date. Any deadlines listed in the Scott Scoop supersede this document.*
