



Armyworm

Life cycle

- ◆ Larvae may over-winter in Iowa
- ◆ Spring-laid eggs, April or early May
- ◆ Attracted to grass, heavy residue (spring-kill grass, cover crop, no-till)
- ◆ Usually feed at night
- ◆ At 1.5 inches burrow in soil & pupate
- ◆ Moths emerge in 2 to 3 weeks
- ◆ 2 to 3 generations per year
