

# Jackson County Volunteer Committees

These are the working committees of the Jackson County 4-H Program. Some committees, such as the Youth and Endowment committees, have fixed membership numbers, but most committees are open to as many members as sign up!

## Membership & Recruitment

Description: Evaluate current and past 4-H membership trends. Develop a retention and membership recruitment county plan. Plan recruitment and retention activities for the county.

Dates: September, December, March, June

## Basketball

Description: Organize and manage the 4-H Basketball Tournament.

Dates: November, January, March, May

## Recognition

Description: Create a recognition county program for 4-H'ers and volunteers.

Dates: August, September, November

## Endowment

Description: Management of 4-H Endowment funds. Develop and organize fundraising activities.

Dates: March, June, September, December

## Youth Committee

Description: The Youth Committee of Jackson County is the governing body of 4-H in the county. Through its channels, rules and regulations for 4-H membership, projects, exhibition, out-of-county events, awards and various other areas are formed.

Dates: Monthly or as needed

## Fair

Description: Review and recommend fair book rule changes. Evaluate fair procedures, schedule, and work with the Fairboard regarding 4-H fair issues.

Dates: January, February, May, June, July, August

## Volleyball

Description: Organize and manage the 4-H Volleyball Tournament

Dates: April, June, July

## 4-H Alumni Tailgate

Description: Organize and manage the 4-H Alumni Tailgate at the Jackson County Fair.

Dates: December/January, May, July

## Project Fair

Description: Plan and manage the 4-H Project Fair including selecting topics and finding presenters.

Dates: December, February, March

Livestock Committees: Beef, Sheep, Dairy, Goat, Pets, Rabbits, Poultry, Dog, Horse, Swine, Bucket/Bottle Calf, Small Animal Auction, Beef Auction

Description: Oversee the specific livestock project area and report to the Youth Committee on all rule changes and issues.

Dates: One required meeting and as needed per committee

Food Stand

Description: Manage the operations of the 4-H Food Stand.

Dates: As needed

Clothing Event

Description: Organize and manage the 4-H Clothing Event program.

Dates: As needed

Description: Organize and manage the 4-H Communications events.
