## Club Organization

- \_\_\_ 1. The club has one Organizational Leader and one Assistant or Project Leader enrolled.
- \_\_\_ 2. Club elects and installs officers and has them perform duties of their respective offices.
- \_\_\_ 3. 4 of 6 club officers participate in countywide officers training.
- \_\_\_ 4. Leaders attend two Leader meetings.
- \_\_\_ 5. Club keeps a yearly historian's book.
- \_\_\_ 6. Club keeps a secretary's book.
- \_\_\_ 7. Club keeps a treasurer's book.
- \_\_\_ 8. Reporter turns in 80% of reports to the office one week after meeting.
- \_\_\_ 9. Leaders turn in necessary enrollment forms, program and/or project information on time.

## Club Program

- \_\_\_ 10. Each member, leader and the Extension Office has a copy of a planned yearly program by Dec.1<sup>st</sup> deadline.
- \_\_\_ 11. Each member gave a presentation or held some leadership role at a club meeting during the year. (talk, demonstration, reports, panel discussions, lead pledge, lead recreation, etc.)
- \_\_\_ 12. Club held 10 meetings throughout the year with average of 75% attendance.
- \_\_\_ 13. Club conducted a local achievement show, club tour, educational tour or workshop.
- \_\_\_ 14. Club held one or more family activities. (parties, potluck, camp out, skating party, etc.)
- \_\_\_ 15. 80% of club members turned in record keeping for the 4-H year.
- \_\_\_ 16. Every member served as host, hostess, or on a committee.
- \_\_\_ 17. County Youth Committee member attended a local club meeting by invitation.

## Club Participation in County 4-H Activities and Events

- \_\_\_ 18. 90% or more of members exhibited at the county fair or achievement show.
- \_\_\_ 19. 50% or more of members participated in Educational Presentations, Working Exhibits, Share the Fun, Fashion Revue or Clothing Selection Contest.
- \_\_\_ 20. 50% of club members attended a 4-H camp, State 4-H Conference, other conferences, 4-H County Event, Leadership, County Council, Teen Club, etc (Any out of club activity).
- \_\_\_ 21. 70% of club members attended Awards Program.
- \_\_\_ 22. 60% of club members participated in fair clean up (which includes pre fair, post fair and during fair according to criteria being met).
- \_\_\_ 23. Club hosted the 4-H exhibit Building for the 3 hours during the fair.

## Service to Others and Public Relations

- \_\_\_ 24. Club completed one or more community service projects throughout the year.
- \_\_\_ 25. Club helped acquaint the public with 4-H (4-H display, float, posters in schools or businesses, program for community, etc.)
