Guidelines:

- ✓ Awarded to two (2) graduating senior high school 4-H'ers in the amount of \$250, to be distributed at the completion of the school year.
- ✓ Submit the completed application and two letters of recommendation – one from your 4-H club leader and one from a non-relative adult of your choice.
- ✓ Complete a 10-minute interview with the scholarship selection committee.
- ✓ Recipients will be announced at the annual 4-H Awards Banquet.

Criteria:

The scholarship selection will be based upon those attributes important to Bonnie. Serving the people and youth of Madison County for 40 years through Iowa State University Extension, Bonnie became a friend, role model and left a lasting impression on all those she touched. Integrity, honesty and dedication were a few of the many qualities that Bonnie possessed and hoped 4-H would help to instill in Madison County's youth. The selection will also be based on involvement in 4-H, leadership, school and community activities, and the completeness of this application.
