Or, if you like working in groups or planning/ organizing special programs, then **LEADERSHIP** is all about you. Learn to be a good leader or become a mentor. Camera buffs will like showing others what you see in the world in the **PHOTOGRAPHY**. Do you like to create and explore painting, drawing, or working clay? Make a masterpiece in the **VISUAL ARTS** project. Try **MUSIC** and be your neighborhood American Idol...

Group B— FAMILY & CONSUMER SCIENCES:

If you like to cook, babysit, learn about nutrition and staying fit or go shopping, then **FAMILY & CONSUMER SCIENCES** offers projects just for you. Learn about kids on the grow, babysitting and child care in the **CHILD DEVELOPMENT**. Be a wise consumer and learn better management practices in **CONSUMER MANAGEMENT**. Find inexpensive ways to do a room makeover in **HOME IMPROVEMENT**. From food selection to preparation, you'll learn all about a healthy diet in **FOODS & NUTRITION**. The **HEALTH** project takes exercise and first aid to another level. If you like to use machines to be creative, check out fashion and clothing construction in the **SEWING** project.

Group C — AGRICULTURE & NATURAL

RESOURCES: This group likes to explore soils, bugs, crops and plants through **CROP PRODUCTION**

& **HORTICULTURE**. And if you like camping and being outdoors, you might consider the **OUTDOOR ADVENTURES** or **SAFETY & EDUCATION IN SHOOTING SPORTS** projects. . Group D— ANIMALS: Pets
