Clothing Selection – To take part in this event you are to select an outfit, wear it for the judge and share why you chose this outfit, and then model it at the style show. An application form will have to be filled out by the member after the entry has been sent in.

Fashion Revue – The main difference between this project and clothing selection is the 4-H'er constructs the outfit during the current 4-H year, models it for the judge and later at the style show. Also requires an application form.

Challenge- This is a fun way to put your thriftiness to the test. All Senior Division 4-H members (grades 10,11,12) are welcome to participate. The requirements are:

- 1.) Cost of outfit must be \$15 or less, not including shoes, accessories, or undergarments.
- 2.) Receipts MUST be turned in with Clothing Event Form
- 3.) Purchase an outfit that represents the 4-H'ers goal or intended use for the selected outfit.
- 4.) Have had individual planned or county experience in choosing shopping alternatives, evaluating fit, quality and construction features, price and cost comparison.
- 5.) Outfits must be selected and/or purchased from a garage sale, consignment store or resale shop (i.e. Goodwill, Salvation Army).

Trophies will be awarded to the Communications and Fashion winners in the Junior, Intermediate and Senior divisions.

Two senior members are eligible to go to the State Fair and 2 intermediate members will be eligible to go to Coralville August 5th.
