



Don't forget! Enrollment cards are due to the Extension Office by November 15th. There are some changes to the enrollment process this year:

1. Financial assistance will only be provided for the state development fee of \$30.00. Members and their families will be responsible for the county fee of \$5.00. All financial assistance forms must be filled out completely and returned to the Extension Office by November 15th. All families applying for financial aid must submit proof of enrollment in the free and reduced school lunch program (approved application, letter from school, etc.). Questions about financial aid can be directed to Mary Kramer at mkramer@iastate.edu.
2. All forms must be signed by the club organizational leader. Enrollments without signatures will be returned.
3. All forms must have accompanying payment. Clubs are encouraged to write ONE club check to ISU Extension for all club enrollments. Remember, Clover kids, Discovery members, and adult volunteers do not pay enrollment fees. Check with your club to see how they are handling the enrollment fees.
4. **All enrollment forms must have the proper medical release forms.** These forms are available from your club leader. All medical release and code of conduct forms are due by November 15th.
5. If members would like a paper copy of the 4-H Focus newsletter mailed to their house, they must check the appropriate box on the enrollment form and return a \$15 check with their form. This check can be made out to ISU Extension. Newsletters are still free via the web and email.
