Membership Awards

4-H members are recognized for successfully completing **1st, 5th, 8th, 9th plus years** of 4-H work. Successful completion includes completing a record keeping system.

Outstanding Junior

One outstanding junior is recognized for outstanding record keeping in a variety of project areas.

Achievement

Intermediate/Senior 4-H member; Three or more years of 4-H work; Demonstrated leadership and citizenship beyond local club; Participation in a variety of 4-H project areas; Growth in knowledge; All of the requirements must be reflected in the record keeping system.

Agriculture

Intermediate/Senior 4-H member; Three or more years of 4-H work; Demonstrated leadership and citizenship beyond local club; Growth in knowledge and respect for all areas of Iowa agriculture and its importance to the community; Development of skills essential to becoming an active, responsible citizen; All of the requirements must be reflected in the record keeping system.

Citizenship

Intermediate/Senior 4-H member; Three or more years of 4-H work; Demonstrated leadership beyond local club; Growth in knowledge; Awareness of relationship to family, peers, state, nation and the world; Demonstration of life skills essential to becoming an active, responsible citizen; Respect for the needs and rights of others; All of the requirements must be reflected in the record keeping system.

Leadership

Intermediate/Senior 4-H member; Three or more years of 4-H work; Demonstrated citizenship beyond local club; Growth in knowledge; Understanding of roles, attitudes, tasks and functions of effective leaders; Strengthens 4-H clubs by assuming leadership responsibility and encouraging other youth; Demonstrates leadership skill and abilities on the county level; All of the requirements must be reflected in the record keeping system.

I Dare You

Intermediate 4-H member; Three or more years of 4-H work; Demonstrated leadership and citizenship beyond local club; Growth in knowledge; Demonstration of efforts to reach his/her highest potential; Is a positive influence to others; All of the requirements must be reflected in the record keeping system.

AK-SAR-BEN

Intermediate/Senior 4-H member; Three or more years of 4-H work; Demonstrated leadership and citizenship beyond local club; Demonstrates self-confidence, imagination and creativity; Growth in knowledge; All of the requirements must be reflected in the record keeping system.
