In the April 4-H Scene the new 4-H fair classes were announced. Since there were so many changes, the Iowa 4-H Office wants to help 4-H members, parents and volunteers know how to prepare projects for fair. The state staff have created "Exhibit Tip Sheets" for each individual project area.

You will want to bookmark this site. It is important 4-H members look through this information because some of the information won't be listed in the fair book.

- What the judge looks for; that will include the 3 goal questions along with other information needed for the fair write-up.
- Other information could include adding the design elements and art principles or including the extra information needed for photography, food or other project exhibits.
- Videos on how the 4-H member can prepare their vegetables for fair.

Along with the Exhibit Tip Sheets, the Project Hot Sheets will give you ideas on different exhibits you could prepare for fair and resources on the project.

## Iowa 4-H Youth Conference

Iowa 4-H Youth Conference is June 28-30 for youth who have completed 8 – 12 grade (yes, you don't have to be in 4-H to go to Iowa 4-H Conference).

Registration information is due May 10 in the Woodbury office. Cost is \$140. Plymouth and Woodbury will again have a bus go down the day before on June 27. There is no cost for the bus for Woodbury 4-H members.

Non-4-H members and youth not in Woodbury County 4-H will need to pay \$50 for their bus fare. There will be an additional cost of \$25 to stay in the dorms the night before. The bus will be first come first serve.

**Adults needed to chaperone:** Each county must have an adult female and male chaperone going to State Conference. This is a wonderful opportunity to be a part of State Conference. Woodbury County will pick up all fees for adult chaperones.

Due to funding, CSI: Crops has been dropped. Youth are encouraged to chose Round-up or Conference.

## FSQA Testing Dates

**4-H'ers who are in 7th, 8th & 9th Grade** as of January 1, 2011, and plan to exhibit any of these animals: Beef, Dairy Cattle, Goats, Poultry, Rabbits, Sheep and/or Swine, you have the option to test out or attend a FSQA workshops. It is recommended that you test if you are in grades 7-9 as of January 1, 2011. You will not have to test out again until you are in the 10th grade.

**4-H'ers who are in 10th, 11th & 12th Grade** and older as of January 1, 2011, **MUST** take the test. When you test out that will be the last test you will need to take.

# Dog Project Members Obedience Classes

Obedience Classes for Dog 4-H Project members will be held again this year. Bring a copy of your dog's current shots and rabies certificate to the first class. Make sure your dog has a buckle collar or choke collar and a 6 foot nylon or leather lead. All 4-H'ers who attend the training must have the Iowa 4-H Medical Information/Release form on file ...check with your 4-H Leader if you are unsure if you have turned in this *important* form.

4-H'ers planning to show their dog at the Woodbury County Fair must fill out a Livestock Identification form that will be due on or before May 15 (sent out in the April *4-H Scene*) or go online to identify your animal at:

<https://iowa.4honline.com>. 4-H'ers exhibiting dogs at the Woodbury County Fair must also fill out a 4-H Fair Animal/Livestock Entry Form that is due July 15.

Youth not already in 4-H who would like to be in the Dog Project may fill out an enrollment form, medical form, ethic form and pay the \$30 enrollment fee.

## Information for Out of County Shows

Listed below is information on State Fair (State Fair book is only available online), Clay County (Clay County rule books are available at the Woodbury County Extension office or use last year’s book) and Ak-Sar-Ben (Ak-Sar-Ben rule book is only available online). *Entry forms will be available at the Woodbury County Extension office in early summer for Clay County. State fair 4-H entry forms are only available on-line at <https://iowa.4honline.com>.*

Entry fees vary for each show. It is the responsibility of each 4-H’er and their parents to read the rule book and follow entry rules. No entries will be accepted after the entry due date. Fees must also be paid at entry time.

### **Iowa State Fair, Aug. 11 - 21. Entries & fees Due July 1**

Livestock/Animal, Dog and Horticulture entries are due July 1. 4-H Building exhibits are selected during County Fair. 4-H’ers must have completed grade 5 to be eligible to exhibit at state fair. Premium books and open class entry forms will be available online at [www.iowastatefair.org](http://www.iowastatefair.org) beginning in late May. ### **Clay County Fair, Sept.10 -18. Entries & fees Due July 15**

Livestock entries and fees are due in the Woodbury Extension office on Friday, July 15. Additional sheep and swine may be identified for the Clay County Fair - contact the Woodbury office for details before May 15. 4-H’ers must wear an official Clay County T-shirt. ### **Ak-Sar-Ben, Sept. 22 - 25 . Entries & fees due August 12**

Livestock and horse entries are due Friday, August 12 in the Woodbury Extension office. Horse exhibitors must be 12 years old by January 1, 2011. Other exhibitors must be 10 years old by January 1, 2011. Go to the following web site: [www.aksarben.org](http://www.aksarben.org) for more information on Ak-Sar-Ben. The rule book is only available online and will be out in early summer.

**Please note:** 4-H’ers who plan to exhibit hogs, lambs, meat goats and feeder calves must have the animal identified on the Sunday, May 15 Livestock Identification forms, but all DNA must be in the Extension office by June 1 to exhibit at Ak-Sar-Ben. Market Beef have already been identified.

### **Recording your Animal’s Health**

Now that most of the 4-H members have their animal projects. It is important that you start keeping records of their health and the medicines that you give your animals. 4-H members may go online at: <http://www.extension.iastate.edu/4h/StateFair/livestock.htm> and look for “Drug Affidavits” on that site. There are forms for: Beef, Horse, Meat Goats, Sheep and Swine. The forms are required for State Fair and especially for Swine for county fair.

## Livestock ID Forms – Due May 15

4-H'er members wanting to exhibit livestock/ animals at the Woodbury County Fair are reminded to submit the county livestock ID form, enter their animal in 4-H Online at:

<https://iowa.4honline.com> or request the state ID forms.

The exceptions are the market sheep and meat goats – 4-H members will be given the forms at the Saturday, May 7 weigh-in and tagging. 4-H'ers that plan to exhibit at the Iowa State Fair must identify their animals in 4-H Online or use the State ID forms.

### **Livestock/animals that must be identified**

**include:** Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goats, Meat Goats, Breeding Heifers, Sheep, Swine, Cow-calf pairs, Feeder Calf, Horse and Dogs.

Market Beef were identified back in January.

Any animals that attend a county weigh-in: market beef, sheep, meat goats the 4-H'er will need to go to 4-H Online to verify their animals.

## Livestock Reminders

All market pigs and feeder calves must be tagged with the Iowa 4-H tag and pigs must be ear notched by Sunday, May 15. Tags are available at the Woodbury County Extension.

Sheep tagging and state fair retinal scanning will be held at the Woodbury County Fairgrounds on Saturday, May 7, 8:00 a.m. – Noon.

Meat goat tagging and state fair retinal scanning will be held at the Woodbury County Fairgrounds on Saturday, May 7, 9:00 a.m. – Noon. Other goats will be able to be tattooed on that day.

Ak-Sar-Ben will require DNA for feeder calves, sheep and goats. DNA envelopes and information is available at the Woodbury County Extension office.

## Pullorum Testing set for June 30

### For 4-H Poultry Projects

All poultry exhibited at county fair must come from U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid clean or equivalent flocks (this means the location where your poultry is housed is NPIP certified (National Poultry Improvement Plan) or have a negative Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days of public exhibition and the test must have been performed by an authorized tester. The majority of 4-H members who exhibit poultry will not be NPIP certified and will have to have their birds tested if they plan to exhibit at county fair.

The county testing date will be held on Thursday, June 30, 4:30 p.m. -7:00 p.m. at the Woodbury County Fairgrounds. Cost is 50 cents per bird (except doves and pigeons).

4-H members may have another Iowa certified tester test their birds, which needs to be done within 90 days of county fair.
