Pig-of-Merit and Performance Pen of Three Weigh-in and Tagging Set for April 14 at Fairgrounds

Pig-of-Merit and the Performance Pen of Three are classes for swine members to learn more about the carcass program and what it takes to grow a quality animal.

Eight (8) pigs may be entered in the Pig-of-Merit and Performance Pen of Three program and must be tagged and weighed on Saturday, April 14, 9:00 am – 11:00 am at the County Fairgrounds in Merville. **There is no weight limit on pigs being weighed on April 14, but the 4-H'er or Family member must be present to weigh the animal.** Two animals may be shown at the fair in the Pig-of-Merit class and 4-H'ers may also show one Performance Pen of Three. (Pigs that are not shown in the Pig-of-merit and Performance Pen of Three can be shown in the regular market class.) Pigs will have the data scanned for the contest. Dennis Rumohr, Swine Superintendent can help answer your questions. His phone is 712-873-3337.

Please note: 4-H'ers who plan to exhibit hogs at County Fair, State Fair and the Clay County fair must attend the FSQA training. Woodbury's training will be held on Thursday, April 26 at the Merville Methodist Church. All swine must be identified on the Livestock Identification Form. The ID Form is due on May 15 to the Woodbury County Extension Office.

Livestock Identification Report Form – due May 15

Enclosed is a 4-H Livestock identification form. This form is for 4-H'ers exhibiting: Breeding Heifers, Cow/Calf, Feeder Calf, Market & Dairy Goats, Dairy Cattle, Swine, Horse and Dogs. Lamb Tagging and Weigh Date is May 12

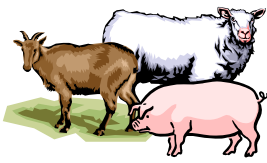
Please note that this is the second Saturday of May

All market (includes the pen of 5 fat lamb class), commercial ewe and ram lambs must be ear tagged and weighed on May 12, at the Woodbury County Fair Grounds from 8:00 am – 11:00 am. 4-H'ers will receive a Sheep Identification (ID) Form at the weigh-in. This form is due at the weigh-in or on or before May 15. 4-H'ers who plan to show a registered lamb must have registration number and birthdate on the ID Form by May 15.

4-H'ers may weigh and identify 12 market lambs, 12 breeding ewes and 5 lambs for the fat lamb class. See last year's fair book for the number of animals that can be exhibited at county fair. 4-H'ers who plan to show a ewe in the Production Yearling Ewe Class (#6035) will not need to re-tag the animal, **but it must be listed on this year's identification form.** Tags cost \$1.50 each. For more information contact Sheep Superintendents: Alan Ralston 712-873-3471 or Penny Yaremko 712-372-4722.

Please Note: 4-H'ers who want to exhibit lambs at the Iowa State Fair and/or Ak-Sar-Ben will need to bring their lambs to the May 12th Tagging and Weigh-in for verification. Lamb will be for tagged, noseprinted and DNA extracted. The 4-H'er and a parent must be present for the verification on May 12. If the 4-H'er is not present – a waiver form must be signed and brought to the weigh-in; and if the parent is not present – the parent must sign a waiver form. Forms can be requested from the Extension Office or you may go to the following website: <http://www.extension.iastate.edu/4H/Agriculture/index.htm>. The Sheep Identification Form is due on May 15; it is important that all information is on the ID form and turned into the Extension Office on or before May 15.

Meat Goats: 4-H'ers who want to exhibit meat goats at the Iowa State Fair must also have their animals tagged & verified on May 12, 8:00am – 11:00 am at the Fairgrounds in Merville.



Food Safety Quality Assurance (FSQA)



Workshop will be held April 26, 7- 8:30 pm at the Merville Methodist Church.

This Workshop is required for 4-H'ers who are 9, 10 and 11 years old as of January 1, 2007 and who plan to exhibit beef (market, breeding, feeder calf, cow/calf), dairy cattle, goats (dairy and meat), poultry (all types of birds), rabbits, sheep and swine, at the Woodbury County Fair, Iowa State Fair and Clay County Fair.

4-H'ers who are 12, 13 and 14 years old as of January 1, 2007 have the option of testing out or attend the April 26 FSQA workshop. Helping take care of your animals and doing chores will help you with the test. It is recommended that you test out.



4-H'ers who are 15 years old and older as of January 1, 2007 **MUST** take the test. When you test out in the 15 & up age group that will be the last test you will need to take for FSQA.



There is a workbook available at the Extension Office. The cost is \$2.00. 4-H'ers can request a Pork Quality Assurance (PQA) workbook and those are free. Youth can take the test as many times as needed to pass. Testing will be done at the Extension Office and testing dates will be set after registrations are due.

Registrations are due at the Woodbury County Extension Office by Monday, April 23, so that we will have enough supplies available at the meeting.

General Livestock

#7. 4-H'ers and FFA members must show their own animals. A substitute show person may be approved in the event: A. Exhibitor has multiple entries showing the same class or

B. Injury or illness of exhibitor.

A substitute show person must be an active 4-H/FFA member. It is expected in such cases the substitute show person needs to be brought to the attention of clerk checking animals into show ring.

3. 4-H/FFA Animal/Livestock Fair Entry Form due at the Woodbury County Extension Office on July 13, 2007 by 4:30 pm. Horse exhibitors must include class information on the Animal/Livestock Fair Entry Form. This information had been due on Fair Entry night.

Beef Weigh-in and tagging for 2008 will be on January 5, 9 am - noon

#1 All tagged lambs must be born on or after January 1, 2007 except in production ewe class 6035

#6: No home grown lamb class (class #6080 has been eliminated)

#9: The “ten” has been eliminated and will read...the highest gaining market lamb that have gained .75 lbs or better will be in the top rate-of-gain class

#13/15: This sentence will be added under unethical practices...One warning will be given prior to being excused from the showing for that class.

Under show order: There will be no black or white face/spotted classes – only individual market lamb
