

2009 4-H EXHIBIT BUILDING HOST SCHEDULE

PURPOSES:

1. Welcome visitors.
2. Protect exhibits.
3. **Promote 4-H**

4. Keep exhibit area clean.
5. Give directions.
6. Citizenship activity for records.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Have on duty two or three 4-H members and one adult (club may want to divide time into 2 or 3 shifts.)
2. Wear **host badges** (pick up at information table.)
3. **Talk to youth and families about 4-H. Show posters of 4-H activities. Ask to complete "I want to join 4-H" card.**
4. At least one person sits at table to **sell quilt raffle tickets** and **encourage fairgoers to vote** for quilt blocks and photos.
5. Others **circulate** individually throughout the building to watch exhibits and greet visitors.
6. On Saturday and Sunday, co-ordinate with and help open class home projects and gardening.
7. Pick up litter, sweep floor, and check bathrooms for paper products.
8. Be especially alert when crowds are present for activities on stage.

2009 SCHEDULE FOR CLEANING SHOW RING AND WASH RACKS

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Have at least four club members and one adult present.
2. Supplies including brooms, dust pans, rakes, shovels, and garbage bags are by the 4-H office.
3. Pick up paper litter in bleachers and show ring and put in garbage cans. If needed, empty garbage cans into dumpster.
4. Sweep bleachers, floor, and steps. Dispose of litter into garbage cans and bedding/manure into manure areas
5. **Clean wash rack areas** – beef, horse, and sheep/swine – **especially clean out drains.**
