Appearance

Wash hands often
Be accurate, pleasant with customers

Clean clothes (4-H T shirt if possible), tie back long hair
Avoid talking on cell phones

Workers

At least 2 adults and four youth (more during lunch and supper)
Adults to serve as cashiers, make sandwiches, supervise youth

4-H'ers to take and fill orders. **Use order form** for sandwiches, nachos, tacos
Cashiers should be adults or older members who can make change

Procedures

Due to increased costs, no coupons will be given for working in the foodstand.
Tell the next shift of workers about any specials, problems, suggestions
Let a foodstand co-manager know if you are running low on supplies.

No free items for workers, everyone pays for food and beverages.
Have customer sign all coupons or hole punch Farm Credit Services cards
Use order forms and give to cashier to add up

Jobs to do during every shift

Stir beef burger and taco meat often.
Restock condiments, cups, napkins, pop, ice
Empty trash inside and outside into dumpster (replace liners)

Move cooked hot dogs to front of grill.
Wash off picnic tables outside and counters inside
Pick up litter inside and outside
