

Exotic Animal Display – Division I

1. All exhibitors are expected to read and follow general herdsmanship, livestock rules, health requirements, Code of Ethics and showmanship guidelines in front of Fair Book.
2. **Eligibility of Exhibitors.** Entries are open to 4-H/FFA members enrolled in a related animal project or self determined. An animal science exhibit in the Special Interest exhibit in Division T class 101A could also be an outgrowth of this project.
3. **Eligibility of Animals.**
 - a. Animals, which do not fit into other divisions, are eligible for this class providing health requirements are met (*example*: no swine such as pot-bellied pigs).
 - b. Exotic animals will be on display only and will not be judged. Length of time and location of display will depend upon stalling space available.
 - c. Complete Livestock/Small Animal Entry Form in the back and turn into the EO by the due date.
4. **Display.**
 - a. Complete a stall card for your animal (s). You are also encouraged to prepare a poster with information such as animal's name, species, breed, care, feed, health, age, housing needs, etc.
 - b. Premium money will be awarded, but animal not judged.
 - c. If **space permits**, animals will arrive by 6 pm Wednesday and release at 5 pm on Sunday.
 - d. Exhibitor is responsible for supervision, herdsmanship duties, and care of animals throughout the Fair.
5. **Herdsmanship.** Exotic Animals will be judged twice daily starting Thursday morning. Exhibitors are expected to read and follow the General Livestock Herdsmanship Guidelines.
