

2009 4-H Club Pre-Fair Cleanup

Thursday, July 9th – 7:00 pm



Each club is responsible for bringing the necessary equipment.
Beverages will be available for all adults and youth in 4-H foodstand.

Luther Livewires: Unload **dividers** on south side of Community Building (another club will wash). Repair and wash benches and picnic tables. **Move 4-H picnic tables** to north and west sides of 4-H foodstand (two 8-foot picnic tables and two 6-foot picnic tables go under the awning.) **Move benches** to south sides of all barns and Community Building and around the 4-H Food Stand (Colfax benches go along awning by Food Stand. Jack Pennington benches by swine barn.) (Bring tools, power washer (optional), buckets, rags, tools, gloves, pick-up, and low trailer if possible.)

Madrid Duets: Rabbit and Poultry - Help move benches and picnic tables out of the Rabbit Barn. Unload cages from stages. Set up poultry and rabbit sawhorses, tar paper, and cages as directed by superintendents. Wash champion signs then stack on tables in northeast corner of rabbit barn by species. Rake, pull weeds, and pick up litter around barn, including under awning. (Bring buckets, rags, tools, gloves, weed-eater, pickup and low trailer if possible.)

Peoples Guys and Gals: Beef/Dairy Barn and Pen of 3 Areas – Pick up trash, bedding, leaves inside and outside of building; **clean** beef tie outs and Pen of 3 pens; pull nails; pick up trash and cut/pull tall weeds north of the barns and in west arena. Sweep **Commercial Building**. (Bring rakes, garage brooms, shovels, wheelbarrows, corn knives weed eater, and gloves.)

Town and Country Pioneers, Environmental Interest, Pets, & Photography Clubs: Repair and wash **dividers** and move into Community Building (southeast corner). Hang the signs “4-H Exhibits and Open Class.” **Sweep and clean food stand at horse arena**. (Bring brooms, buckets, rags, tools for repairs, pliers to pull staples, and stepladder.)

Harrison Happy Hustlers and Horse Interest: **South and North Horse Barns** - Pick up trash; rake pens and alleys; pull nails. Clean **horse** and **beef wash racks** including cleaning out drain. Pick up trash and trim weeds as needed at east horse arena and camping areas. (Bring rakes, shovels, garden hose, corn knives, trimmers, pliers, hammers, and gloves.)

Rural & City Newcomers: **Clean the Show Ring** inside (including bleachers, stairs, ring) and outside (including stalls on west side and rest rooms). Pull nails, tacks. If needed, move three (3) **older** tables and 5 chairs into the Show Ring from the Commercial Building. Clean 4-H Livestock Office (fan, floor, cupboards, shelves.) (Bring rakes, brooms, wheelbarrow, rags, buckets, garden hose, pliers, hammers, and gloves.)

Madrid Merry Makers: **Sheep Barn** and **put out trash barrels** Move trash barrels out of sheep barn. Insert liners and put rubber bands around top. Transport barrels around fairgrounds (except none in campgrounds.) Pick up trash and leaves inside and outside of sheep barn; rake pens and alleys; replace light bulbs – as needed; pull nails. Clean sheep wash rack and rain gutters. Pull weeds. (Bring paint brushes, truck, low trailer, rakes, shovels, wheelbarrow, tools, and gloves.)

Boone Guys and Gals: **Hand washing stations/recycling barrels** – set up hand washing stations by hydrants at north and south ends of beef barn, south end of swine barn, south end of Commercial exhibit building (no hydrant), south side of show ring (no hydrant), south side of horse arena, north side of Pen of 3, and north side of rabbit barn (no hydrant.) Put liners in pop recycling barrels and place barrels south side of barns, near 4-H foodstand, and community building.

Boone and Gilbert FFA: Swine Barn – pick up trash, bedding, leaves inside and outside of swine barn. Set up swine pens. Please do before July 9th so swine gates are out of sheep barn.

Green Clovers: **July 6 (or before)** - Vacuum and mop the stage and behind curtains. Wash counters, refrigerators, and stove in **kitchen**. (Bring shop vacuum, cleaner, buckets and rags) **July 14 at 4 pm** - set up booths and judging areas in **Community Building** and help as needed at 4-H Livestock Office and posting signs around the Fairgrounds.

2009 4-H Club Post-Fair Cleanup



Assignments can be done on **Monday**, time depends upon the assigned task.
Each club is responsible for bringing the necessary equipment.
Beverages will be available for all adults and youth.

Boone and Gilbert FFA (Friday): **Swine Barn** Take down swine pens and do final sweeping of the swine barn.

Bluff Creek Wranglers: **South and North Horse Barns** – Pick up all trash inside and outside of barns; make sure all stalls and alleys are clean; take down all signs and pull nails, tacks, etc. Clean horse and beef wash racks - **especially the drain**. Drain **hand washing** stations and move to rabbit barn. (Gloves, tools, wheelbarrow, rakes, hose, shovels, pliers, hammer)

Amaqua Warriors and Southside Pioneers: **Sheep and beef barns** (after auction) – Pick up trash inside and out; clean sheep wash rack; take down all signs and pull nails, tacks, etc. Be sure all pens and alleys are cleaned after animals are loaded out. Do final sweeping of beef barn after beef committee members remove bedding. Pick up litter in all area north of barns, including beef grooming and Pen of 3 areas. (Bring rakes, hose, brooms, shovels, gloves, pliers, hammers, and wheelbarrow.)

Harrison Hilltop Hornets: Stack rabbit and poultry cages in rabbit barn if needed. Move all **benches and picnic tables** into rabbit barn. Move **dividers** and runway into rabbit barn if needed. Help move hand washing stations if needed. (Bring gloves, low trailer, pick up, and manpower!)

Colfax Happy Hustlers: (after auction) pick up litter in the **Show Ring** (bleachers, stairs, and ring); close all windows; move all garbage cans to south-side; take tables and chairs to Community Building; help pack/clean 4-H Livestock Office – take down all signs, pull tacks, etc. (Bring brooms, dustpans, gloves and pliers.)

Prairie Pride: **Pick up trash** in all areas west of Argo Street and south of barns, including carnival area and both sides of Industrial Park Road and Argo Streets, south grandstand, farm equipment display area, around Rabbit Barn, and west booster parking area. Get garbage bags from 4-H Office. (Bring gloves and pokers.)

Montana Miners: **Community Building** - move table and chair racks into storage room (when empty.) Sweep or vacuum big room, meeting rooms, and hallway and **Commercial Building**. Pick up trash around both buildings and Food Stand. Help as needed to empty 4-H **foodstand**. (Bring garage brooms, dustpans, shop vacuum)

Boxholm Blazers: Take plastic liners and cans/ bottles from **recycling barrels** to poultry area and recycling barrels to rabbit barn. Sweep horse arena food stand and wipe out and unplug refrigerator. **Pick up trash** east of Argo Street, including **horse** arena, camping and parking area. (Wheel barrow, pliers, and gloves. Garbage bags from 4-H office.)

Westside Hustlers: Using pickups and/or low trailers to collect **trash barrels** from all over the Fairgrounds. Empty trash into dumpster or as few of the trash barrels or bags as possible. When Sheep Barn is empty and cleaned, put empty barrels upside down in pens. (Bring pickups, low trailers, and gloves.)
