

Monona County 4-H Scholarship

Rules and Regulations

To qualify for a **Monona County 4-H Scholarship**, applicant must:

1. Have been enrolled and participated in a 4-H program for a total of four years, with two of these years including the Junior and Senior years in school. Must meet County attendance policy to be eligible.
2. Be enrolled in a post high school education or military program.
3. Include a letter of support from your 4-H leader.
4. Have maintained at least a 2.0 (C) average in high school.
5. Only completed applications will be considered.
6. Application is limited to space on this form.

It is possible that you may be asked for a personal interview as the committee reviews the applications. Recipient(s) of this scholarship will be announced at the time of high school graduation. Checks will be presented at that time. Scholarships will be a minimum of \$200.

All applications must be returned by **April 1st**.
