<u>Clover Kids</u>	<u>4-H Clubs</u>
Focuses on doing	Focuses on goal setting and working towards goals
Non-competitive	Participants keep records of their progress toward goals
Teaches life skills for grades K-3	Teaches life skills for grades 4-12
Small groups	Larger on-going groups
