Ida County Rabbit Identification Requirements

Ownership:

All animals must be owned by and identified to the individual 4-H'er. Each rabbit must be identified by only one 4-H member.

Identification:

Senior and Intermediate Rabbits must be identified with an ear tattoo that is listed on the Senior Rabbit Identification Form. Rabbits in your herd are to be identified by breed, color/variety, date of birth, sex and tattoo on a Senior Rabbit Identification Form due in the extension Office by May 15. These rabbits will have birthdates before February 15 of the current year. If your rabbit does not have a tattoo, include a color photograph of each animal.

Meat Pens don't need to be tattooed at this time, but must be listed on the Identification Form in the Junior Section.

Junior Rabbits that will be shown at the fair which are too young to be tattooed or not yet born by the May 15 date must be listed by their breed and approximate birthdate on the rabbit Identification Form in the Junior Section.

It is recommended that junior rabbits shown at the Ida County Fair be a minimum of eight weeks of age at show time and meet the weight qualifications listed in the Standard of Perfection book.

Returning your ID Sheet:

Return the identification sheet by May 15th of the current year to the county extension office.
