## Clay County Poultry Identification Requirements

1. To exhibit an animal project, a 4-H member must:
  - Currently be in the fifth grade or higher, at fair time.
  - Be younger than 19, by September 15 of the previous year.
  - Not have graduated from high school before the calendar year in which he/she plans to participate.
2. FFA members must be in good standing with the local and state associations.
3. Exhibitors must be involved in a 4-H club or FFA chapter in Iowa or the following Minnesota counties: Pipestone, Murray, Cottonwood, Watonwan, Rock, Nobles, Jackson, Martin, and Faribault.

### Ownership:

All animals must be owned by and identified to the individual 4-H'er. When registration papers are involved, the papers must either be in the 4-H'er's name or show a logical family relationship. Animals changing ownership after being identified as a project are ineligible to be exhibited as 4-H animals for the 4-H year.

Wild turkey, guinea, ornamental fowl, pheasants, laying hens, geese, pigeons, wild ducks, and bantam ducks may be older than 1 year and may be purchased as adults. Adult birds must be owned by the member on or before May 10th. All other poultry projects must be raised by the member from a chick hatched after January 1.

### Health Requirements:

All County and District Exhibitors are required to have Health Certificates. All poultry must come from a U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid clean or equivalent flock, or have a negative Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days of the Clay County Fair.

### Identification:

All poultry that a 4-H'er may want to exhibit at the Clay County Fair MUST be identified on the Poultry Identification Form.

### Returning your ID Sheet:

Return the identification sheet by May 10<sup>th</sup> of the current year to your county Extension Office. A copy of your ID will be provided.

### Ak-Sar-Ben Requirements:

Check with your County Extension Office for Ak-Sar-Ben and State Fair requirements.

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
