Iowa 4-H Poultry Project

Regulations Pertaining to County, State and Interstate Shows

Age of exhibitors

1. To be eligible for a state or interstate show, a 4-H'er must have completed 5th grade **prior to the event** unless a particular show is more restrictive.
2. A 4-H'er becomes ineligible to exhibit beyond the county level upon completion of the calendar year of high school graduation. Note: In the event that a 4-H'er has dropped out of high school, the 4-H'er is only eligible to exhibit livestock through the calendar year that his/her class graduated.

Ownership

All poultry must be owned by and identified to the individual 4-H'er. Poultry changing ownership after being identified as a project are ineligible to be exhibited as 4-H poultry for that 4-H year.

Exhibitor may offer one Ribbon for sale in the 4-H/FFA Fair Ribbon Auction.

Identification

All poultry in your project may be identified; however, fair exhibitors are limited to a maximum of six entries at the Kossuth County Fair.

Note: Birds ordered from the market broiler class will be added by the office with the band numbers.

Birds identified as part of a 4-H project cannot also be identified or exhibited as an FFA project.

Deadline

Poultry projects must be identified by May 15. If your project is ordered but has not arrived, please supply as much information as possible (type, breed, number, arrival date) and confirm information after the arrival of chicks.

Special Note

Poultry entered in the poultry classes at the fair may not be entered in the 4-H pet show.

Filing your ID sheet:

Return white copy to your county Extension office by May 15. Retain blue copy for your use.
