Standard Operating Procedure

Contact with Blood and Bodily Fluids

Policy: Blood and other bodily fluids will be handled to minimize the possibility of cross contamination.

Procedure: All employees in school foodservice must:

1. Contain the source of the blood.
2. Wear disposable gloves when exposed to blood or bodily fluids to minimize the risk of contamination.
3. Dispose of contaminated gloves so that they do not come in contact with other people, food, or equipment. Dispose of any contaminated foods.
4. Clean and sanitize any affected food contact surfaces.
5. Follow procedures outlined by the school administration.
6. Seek assistance from someone trained to handle blood or bodily fluids, such as a school nurse, as needed.

NOTE: A Blood-Borne Pathogens Kit should be located in the school, to be used when handling blood is necessary.

The unit supervisor will:

1. Review practices with all employees as part of new employee orientation.
2. Follow up as necessary.
