

# **CAMPING & PARKING RULES FOR MARION COUNTY FAIR**

*All profits from this fund raiser go to the Youth of Marion County through the 4-H Foundation.*

*The following rules are in addition to those in the Marion County Fairbook.*

- ❖ All fair camping fees cost \$35 per spot for the length of fair and will provide a spot approximately 40'x20' for 1 camper and 1 vehicle if there is enough room in the assigned spot
- ❖ **CAMPERS OVER 40' IN LENGTH CAN NOT camp on the fairgrounds but will be placed in the North Campgrounds**
  - Reserved camping request with \$35 per spot fees are due: into the Extension Office by June 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Camping requests received after June 1<sup>st</sup> will be on a first come first serve basis, space permitting
  - Camping requests postmarked or received after June 1<sup>st</sup> will be \$40 per spot; this includes a \$5 late fee
  - Returned checks will be assessed a \$40 returned check fee & your name will go to the bottom of the waiting list (You will still be responsible for the \$35 plus \$5 late fee for the camping spot.)
  - Each club, chapter, group or individual can turn in 2 choices for camping spots
  - Reserved camping spots for duplicate choices will be honored as much as possible
  - Only ONE spot per family because of demand for camping spots
  - Non 4-Her's will be put on a waiting list until after 4-H families are placed where room is available
  - When campgrounds west of barns are full, the over flow will go to North Campgrounds
  - Camping and ear permits will be mailed out to the individuals
- Regulations
  - Fair runs Friday of one week through Thursday of the next week; camping is allowed Thursday before Fair through Saturday after fair.
  - No arrivals before 3:00 pm on Thursday, without prior Foundation Board approval
  - All spots must be cleaned and everything removed by 12:00 Noon Saturday
  - Camper & car permits must be visibly displayed in windows at all times
  - Regular inspection of campgrounds will be made for cleanliness & rules violations
  - Driving lanes must be kept open at all times for emergencies
  - Parking for visitors and extra cars will be by the racetrack
  - We appreciate campers assistance & cooperation in self-enforcing these rules in a reasonable fashion
  - No other vehicle parking in this area will be allowed. A pass is required.
  - One way traffic through campgrounds
  - NO UNAUTHORIZED 4-WHEELERS, BICYCLES OR GOLFCARTS ALLOWED ON FAIRGROUNDS.
  - Quiet hours to be observed from 11 pm to 6 am
  - No animals in campgrounds
  - Each camper with minors must have a responsible adult staying each night.
- ❖ Sunday Horse Show Regulation
  - A lane from the horse barn to show arena and a staging area will be roped off for horse traffic only
  - Handicap parking will be available and transportation to arena will be available
  - Camping area will be barricaded and traffic will be monitored closely
  - Please help us make the show as safe and fun as possible
- ❖ Not complying with the Marion County camping rules & regulations could result in:
  - Vehicles being towed from campgrounds
  - Removal from campgrounds
  - Camping restrictions in future years
  - Forfeiture of camping privileges
- ❖ Livestock trailer parking will be on the northwest side of the track and west of the north grandstand
- Exhibitor and visitor parking will be north of the beef barn and west of the track
- The Fairground security & the Sheriff will assist the Foundation in enforcing the rules and regulations

Head: Strongly recommend alcohol free

Heart: considerate of other campers, loud parties will stop at 11 pm

Hands: Campgrounds will be kept neat & picked up of trash

Health: Sleeping permitted, no underage smoking or drinking & NO DRUGS!!!
