Boone County 4-H Council Points for Membership

(Approved by Boone County Youth & 4-H Committee May 19, 1997 and by Boone County 4-H Council June 8, 1997)

- Goals: To increase teen participation in Boone County 4-H leadership roles.
To encourage commitment and active membership on the Boone County 4-H Council.
To encourage participation in local, county, and beyond county 4-H activities.

Membership on Boone County 4-H Council is open to 4-H'ers who are high school **sophomores to seniors** based upon earning points. Points are earned by attending meetings, volunteering, taking on local and county leadership roles, and becoming involved in county and state 4-H activities. **Ten points** need to be earned by prospective (new) members and **twenty points** by returning members **between September 1 through the following August**. This form (completed and signed) is due to the Boone County Extension Office by **August 10**. In late August, the current year's County 4-H Council Officers and/or advisors will check points. Points will not be held over from year to year.

New and returning County 4-H Council members will begin terms on September 1 and will be installed at Awards Day in November. Council members will hold a one-year term and will need to accumulate 20 points while on County 4-H Council to qualify for the next year (including at least 5 points for attendance at meetings). High School seniors need to earn at least 10 points during the year in order to be recognized at the 4-H Awards Day following graduation.
