Norman has been involved in 4-H one way or another since 1947 when he joined the Win or Bust 4-H club. He remained in 4-H for 11 years holding all offices in his local club. Since then, he has served as Boys County 4-H President, as a counselor at 4-H Camp, on the Youth Committee for 12 years, as a 4-H leader for the Win or Bust Club for 8 years, on the Clinton County Fair Board for 35 years, and has been selected to the Clinton County Fair Board Hall of Fame.
