

Boone County 4-H/FFA Horse Exhibitors

What to Bring to Fair

1. Gate - one for every horse you bring 4' X 8' painted white (may need one extra per club for a horse on the end.) Diagram for gates available from Extension Office.
2. Metal post with the "V" at the bottom cut off
3. Top of post must be even with gate or be covered with PVC pipe with an end cap.
4. Wheel Barrow
5. Pitch Fork
6. Rake
7. Flat Back Bucket
8. Shovel
9. Grain Pan
10. Hay Bag
11. Brushes (Soft Bristled & Hard Bristled)
12. Curry Combs
13. Fly Spray
14. Baby Oil
15. Hoof Polish (Clear or Black)
16. Garden Hose
17. Shampoo
18. Conditioner (Mane and Tail)
19. Sweat Scraper
20. Scissors
21. Old Rag
22. Lead Rope -3/4" cotton or nylon with a bull snap and bring an extra one

23. Mane and Tail Comb
24. Optional Tack Box
25. Wood chip type bedding

Things You Need For Showing

1. Saddle
2. Bridle
3. Blanket
4. Show Halter
5. Show Lead Rope

The Proper Attire for You to Show In At County Fair

1. Dark Blue Jeans
2. Long sleeved white shirt
3. Hard Soled Boots or Shoes
4. 4-H Emblem or Arm Band on long sleeved white shirt. These can be purchased at the Extension Office or the Livestock Office at Fair
5. Helmet when mounted/riding or cowboy hat for halter class
6. Proper English attire in English Pleasure and Equitation
