1. Members may exhibit a **maximum** of eight (8) breeding and one (1) market pen of three.
1. Members may exhibit a **maximum** of two (2) entries in a buck or doe class.
2. Junior bucks and does are under six months of age. Senior bucks and does are over six months of age. Use the show date as the date to determine age for class entry.
3. Exhibitors should verify sex of rabbit before fair.
4. All rabbits must be permanently identified with a tattoo in the left ear if planning to exhibit at the Iowa State Fair.
5. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS - All rabbits must be disease free.
6. Space will be provided for each exhibitor and his/her rabbits. Rabbits must be housed in assigned cages that are provided.
7. Commercial/Fancy rabbits will be judged following the current American Rabbit Breeder's Association Standard and rules.
8. If there are 3 or more rabbits in a class, the class will then be broken down by breed. If there are 2 or less rabbits, they will be shown in another breeds class.
9. A partial list of rabbits - fancy and commercial breeds - is listed here.

10. Premium Ribbons will be as follows unless otherwise noted: Blue, Red & White. First and second place will receive purple and lavender for each class. Champion and Reserve Champion will receive purple and lavender.

CLASS 5900 – Meat Pens

1. A meat pen will consist of three rabbits. Age limit not over ten weeks and weight limit not over five pounds each. Rabbits may be purebred or mixed breed.
2. Members may exhibit one entry in this class.

1. No pre-entry is required in this division.
2. Showmanship judging will be after all judging is done.
3. Senior Showmanship, Intermediate Showmanship, Junior Showmanship. Ribbons and trophies will be awarded.
