### **Obedience Classes**

1. Judging will be based on obedience.
2. Dogs that are exhibited in the dog obedience class will **not** be eligible to show in the pet class.
3. Current rabies vaccination certificate must be shown at the 4-H Office on the fairgrounds between 3:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m. on Wednesday of Fair Week.
4. Classes are based on the number of years the dog that is being exhibited has received training.
5. Class 3150 through Class 3190 Premium Ribbons - Blue, Red & White. First and second place purple and lavender for each class. Champion and Reserve Champion purple and lavender for overall champion.

### **Class 3150 – Pre-Novice**

1. All exercises are done on lead.

### **Class 3170 -- Novice**

1. All exercises are done both on and off lead.

### **Class 3180 – Grad Novice**

1. All exercises are done off lead with the addition of the drop on recall.

### **Class 3190 – Agility**

1. Course to be determined.

### **Handling Classes**

1. An exhibitor is limited to one entry in this class. Classes will be based on the age of the handler and on the number of years of training completed by the handler. Handling classes will be judged using the following showmanship score card:

**Exhibitor (appearance, attitude) -- 15 pts.**

**Dog Grooming & Condition -- 25 pts.**

**Handling -- 30 pts.      Questions -- 30 pts.**

**Total Possible Points -- 100**

2. Classes 3200 through 3223 Premium Ribbons - Blue, Red & White. First and second place purple & lavender for each class. Champion and Reserve Champion purple and lavender for Top Novice and Overall Champion.

**Class 3200 -- Novice Handler (junior and intermediate) in first year of handling training.**

**Class 3210 -- Novice Handler (senior) in first year of handling training.**

**Class 3215 -- Advance Handler (junior and intermediate) in 2<sup>nd</sup> year or beyond of handling training.**

**Class 3220 -- Advance Handler (senior) in 2<sup>nd</sup> year or beyond of handling training.**
