6560 -- Meat Goat

1. All Meat Goats must attend the Sheep weigh-in date set by the 4-H Committee to get a beginning weight and to be tagged. There is a set time frame for meat goats.
2. Exhibitors may identify a maximum of 8 head.
3. Each exhibitor is allowed to exhibit up to 4 meat goats.
4. Bucks, does and wethers may be shown.
5. All meat goats must be weighed in and checked in on check in day of county fair. No reweighs will be allowed.
6. Weight Limit: Meat Goats must weigh a minimum of 40 pounds.
7. Classes will be divided by weight.
8. All breeds show together.
9. Bracing of animal will be up to the judge and announced the day of the show.
10. Meat Goats must have their kid teeth in normal positions at time of check in. Any Meat Goat having lost any kid teeth will be disqualified.
11. No Billy Goats will be allowed.
12. No replacement females will be allowed.
13. Goats are required to have horns disbudded, dehorned or tipped blunt before arrival on fairgrounds.
14. All meat goats are allowed, but not required, to be uniformly clipped with 3/8 inch length of hair or less above the knee and hock joints to include the head, excluding the tail.
15. Ribbons only will be awarded.
