Club Organization

- ___ 1. The club has one Organizational Leader and one Assistant or Project Leader enrolled.
- ___ 2. Club elects and installs officers and has them perform duties of their respective offices.
- ___ 3. At least 4 club officers participate in countywide officers training.
- ___ 4. Each leader attends two county leader meetings.
- ___ 5. Leaders turn in club program and/or project information on time.
- ___ 6. Club keeps a secretary's book.
- ___ 7. Club keeps a treasurer's book.
- ___ 8. Reporter turns in at least six club reports to the office, within two weeks of the meeting.
- ___ 9. Club has 10 meetings.
- ___ 10. 50% of club members turn in record books by September 15.

Club Program

- ___ 11. Each member, leader and Extension Office has copy of a yearly program by November 15.
- ___ 12. Each member gives an educational presentation, working exhibit or share the fun.
- ___ 13. Club conducts a local achievement show, educational tour or workshop.
- ___ 14. Club has at least one family activity. (potluck, camp out, skating party, Christmas party, etc.)
- ___ 15. Each member serves as host, hostess, or on a committee.

Club Participation in County/State 4-H Activities

- ___ 16. At least 90% of members exhibit at county fair.
- ___ 17. At least five members participate in Educational Presentations, Working Exhibits, Share the Fun, Fashion Revue, Clothing Selection, Decorator's Showcase or Fashion Designers, Livestock Judging Contest.
- ___ 18. At least one member attends 4-H camp, State 4-H Conference or other 4-H Event.

Service to Others and Public Relations

- ___ 19. Club completes at least one community service project.
- ___ 20. Club acquaints the public with 4-H (display, float, posters in schools or businesses, etc.) All signs need to include name of club.
