

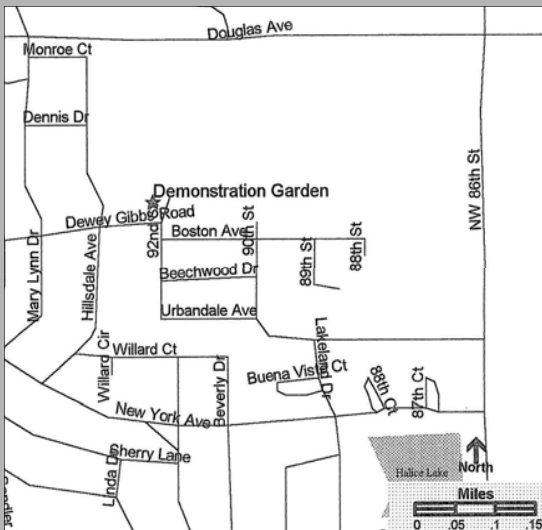
The Demonstration Garden
