You need not pre-register for CIC sessions in our county. If you plan to attend a session in another county, check with that county extension office about preregistration and the arrival time. Call ahead for any meeting that you plan to attend and confirm the date, time, and location of the meeting.

If you have any questions, feel free to contact me. Note that your Private Pesticide Applicator Certification number and the year your certification expires are on the mailing label.

Initial Certification

To become certified initially, you must take the exam offered by the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship (IDALS). A Study Guide (PAT 1) is available for purchase at your local extension office.

Renewing Your Certification

Option 1:

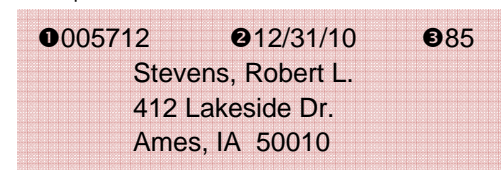
One way to renew your certification is to attend a private applicators' continuing instruction course (CIC) each of the three years during your renewal cycle.

Private CIC Renewal Cycle

To find out when you need to recertify, check the mailing label for your certification number and expiration date. Then follow the directions for your expiration date in this brochure.

Example Label:



- 1 005712 is the certification number.
 - 1st digit of number is expiration year (example: 0 = 2010 expiration).
 - Numeric 2nd digit (0) indicates test was taken for certification.

- If 2nd digit is alphabetic (0A5712), renewal occurred by attending CIC program.
- 2 12/31/10 is the expiration date.
- 3 The number 85 is the county number.

Option 2:

A second way to renew is to pass the certification test every three years. If you miss one year of CIC programs, Iowa law requires you to retest when your certification expires. The exam is given by IDALS. Several testing dates near you are listed within this brochure. If you score 70% or more and pay a \$15 fee, you will be certified for 3 years.

To Recertify with 2010 Expiration

If your certification expires December 31, 2010, **AND** you have attended CIC programs in **BOTH** 2008–2009 and 2009–2010, you can attend a CIC program between December 2010 and April 15, 2011, or retest.

To Recertify with 2011 Expiration

If your certification expires December 31, 2011, and you have attended a CIC program for 2009–2010, you can attend a CIC program for 2010–2011 and 2011–2012, or retest when your certification expires.

To Recertify with 2012 Expiration

If you wish to recertify by training and not by exam, you must attend a CIC session each year, starting this winter. Remember, you always have the option of taking the exam to recertify.
