- On-farm processing dairy processing workshop was held on July 2. 60 attended. 15 from NE IA. Would like more info on cheese making.
- 16 people from NE IA attended the FFI Networking conference in Detroit in June.
- At Plantpeddler—started planting tomato and vegetable seeds. Terry Shogren will be helping with the produce marketing side. Have planted strawberry baskets and primocane raspberries.
- Looking at Veriflora Certified Sustainable Grown: everything has to be holistic to be certified. <http://www.scscertified.com/csrpurchasing/veriflora/>
- Decorah received \$290,000 for trails
- Cucumber plants can survive 3 days under water
- Clayton county has a producer that is looking at a candling facility for eggs
- Should NIFF have gardens at each county fair? Farmers Markets?
- One strategy for the future will be to reinvigorate horticulture production at county fairs and with youth groups.
- Support local food and the fair foodstands
- Bike trail will be going in along Great River Road between Clermont and Elgin and also to connect Clermont to Hwy 150 at Calmar.

**Grant Ends: September 30, 2008**

- **Honorarium/Services – \$1888.82** to pay speakers/consultants fees and or assist with Focus Group Collection and Reports
- Used \$250 to cover \$20 scholarships for 11 people attending the Midwest School for On-Farm Processing sponsored by NICC and NIFF and \$30 for a NIFF booth (bill pending)
- **Will pay \$670** to pay an assistant to gather data for NIFF reporting and photos for 2007 & 2008 small producer grants
- **Will pay \$968.82** for NIFF co-sponsored Field Days (4) - \$100 will be paid to the 4 producers whose farm we will be visiting to assist with food expenses. The remaining \$668.82 will be used to help cover food and expenses incurred through the four field days and the meal for the Fruit and Vegetable Grower's Workshop with Don Dwyer scheduled for the last week of August.

- **Postage – \$201.85**  
Max. of 480 letters to be mailed at .42 ea to promote F&F Field Days OR to bring in a speaker later this summer

**Other Direct – Other – \$1,360.20** for marketing purposes and food and room rental

- \$400.20 to writers, Sarah Marsh and Kristine Jepson to write stories on small producer grant program (June – August 2008)
- \$960 was spent marketing the Regional Buy Fresh/Buy Local Food Directory; producers and institutions contributed to the printing of this directory so that it will become sustainable in the future. (May 2008)

**Deadline: August 25** Annual report to the Wallace Center of Winrock International for our Value Chain Partnerships project.

1. Document increased sales - above the previous year - of fresh, healthy, local (community-based) foods from three food and farming businesses in at least two Iowa communities. Total overall increase at least \$30,000
2. Document additional baseline purchases from local producers in four Iowa communities or counties totaling \$200,000 over the baseline collected last year

3. Leverage \$100,000 in local resources for local food capacity building of producers and entrepreneurs across four Iowa communities or counties.
