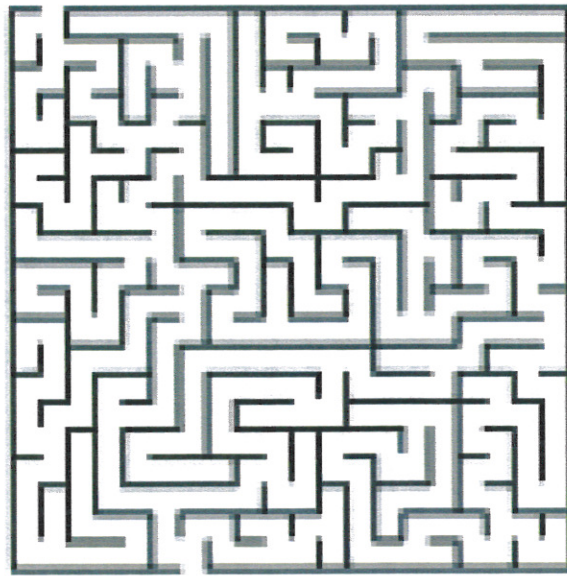
4-H Volunteers must complete the following:
