POULTRY RULES AND REGULATIONS

General and general livestock rules and regulations apply to this department.

1. Exhibitors are limited to not more than ten entries per member.
2. Each entry per class must be a different breed. Pens will be provided. Members must supply feed and water pans.
3. Entries are to be checked in on Tuesday from 6:00-9:00 p.m. Poultry must be removed on Saturday beginning at 7:00 a.m. and the cage area cleaned.
4. Exhibitors who purchased broilers through the Special Broiler program, or turkeys through the Special Turkey project, or those with current pullorum test documents less than 90 days old on entry day, will not need to be tested for pullorum. All other poultry will be tested at entry time. Members must be present to assist in the testing.
5. Only Special Broilers and Special Turkeys (Division 8) can sell ribbons at auction.
6. Members are responsible for the care of their own animals during the fair, and keeping their cages/pens clean. Entries will not be released at the end of fair until the exhibitor's pens are checked by the committee. Failure to check out may result in loss of premium.
7. Each member exhibiting rabbits and poultry must help set-up or tear-down or lose premium. Exhibitors will be mailed a list of expectations and procedures regarding the poultry building. At check in this same information will be available, and ALL exhibitors will be required to sign their name stating that they have read and understand the information.
8. Breeding Birds should be entered as cock, hen, cockerel, or pullet with these terms defined as: Cock-male chicken 1 year old or older; Hen- female chicken 1 year old or older; Cockerel-male chicken less than 1 year old. A pen consists of one male and two females, all old or all young (i.e. one cock and two hens or one cockerel and two pullets). An individual bird may also be shown in a pen.
9. Showmanship classes are open to all poultry exhibitors. Grade divisions (grade completed) are: Jr. - grades 4, 5, & 6; Int. - grades 7, 8, & 9; Sr. - grades 10 and up. Members are not eligible to win the showmanship trophy more than once in each grade division, but are encouraged to enter for ribbon awards.
10. Premiums paid will be: Blue \$4.00 and Red \$2.00

Division 5-Game Birds/Hobby Birds

- 617 Hobby Poultry - 1 pair
(1 male/1 female) in full adult plumage
pigeons, peafowl, doves, ratties, etc.
- 618 Game Birds - 1 pair
(1 male/1 female) in full adult plumage
– Bob white quail, guineas, ornamental pheasants, wild turkeys, partridge, wild waterfowl, and other game birds. (State and federal permits required where applicable)

POULTRY DEPARTMENT (CONT.)

Division 6-Juvenile Poultry (pen of 3)

Entries must be 6 weeks of age or older, and not eligible for any other poultry class.

619 Pen of 3 Juvenile poultry

- a. Chickens
- b. Ducks

Division 7-Home Hatched Class

620 Pen of 3 hatched by June 1

- a. chickens
- b. ducks
- c. other

Division 8-Special Poultry Project

1. Youth will purchase broilers or poults from the County Extension Office. All birds will be from the same hatchery.
2. Youth in the special broiler project are required to bring three broilers to the county fair and youth in the special turkey project are required to bring two turkeys. Record forms will be distributed at chick/poult pick-up day and are due back to the Extension Office by Tuesday, July 05, 2011.
3. The project will be evaluated 50% on live standards and 50% on records which include the records and the interview.

Division 10-Poultry Educational Project/Presentation

1. Each member may have only one entry per class. Entries should be educational in nature.
2. Poster is to be 22 inches by 28 inches in size.
3. An official entry tag label must be attached to entry.
4. No advance entry is required. Entries are to be checked in at the poultry check-in and taken home at poultry release time.
5. Entries in this class are not eligible to advance to State Fair.
6. Public Presentation will be at conclusion of poultry show.
7. Public Presentation will be on any subject related to poultry.
8. Public presentation will not be less than 5 min., and not longer than 8 min.
