GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entries must have been completed by exhibitor since the previous year's fair.
2. Open to all residents of Henry County.
3. Entry tags should be picked up at the Extension Office prior to entry day and filled out. Do not remove bottom part of tag.
4. Diligence will be used to insure safety of articles, but in case of accident we will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
5. Adult exhibitors may enter up to 10 (ten) exhibits in the open class division. Children may enter up to 5 (five) exhibits in the open class division. Exhibitors may enter more than one item in each division, but each entry must be different (example: chocolate chip cookies and cut-out sugar cookies would be two entries in Baked Goods - Cookies; a set of embroidered pillowcases would be entered as one exhibit in the Embroidery Division.
6. Premiums in all departments will be Blue--\$2.00 Red--\$1.00. Entries will be awarded a premium only if deserved.
7. Judges will award Best of Show for any deserving items as they choose.

HORTICULTURE DEPARTMENT

NOXIOUS WEEDS LISTED BELOW ARE NOT ALLOWED:

Primary Noxious Weeds

Buckthorn, Bull thistle, Canada Thistle, Field bindweed, Hoary cress (Perennial Peppergrass), Horsenettle, Leafy spurge, Musk thistle, Perennial sowthistle, Quackgrass, Russian knapweed, Tall thistle.

Secondary Noxious Weeds

Buckhorn plantain, Cocklebur, Wild sunflower, Curly dock, Poison hemlock, Puncturevine, Red sorrel (Sheep Sorrel), Smooth dock, Teasel, Velvetleaf (Butterprint), Wild carrot, Wild mustard, Multiflora rose, Shatttrecane, Purple Loosestrife.

Horticulture Department specimens should be prepared for exhibit as stated in 4H-462 "Harvesting & Preparing Vegetables for Exhibit" and 4H-464 "Preparing Cut Flowers and Houseplants for Exhibit," available at the Extension Office.

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HORTICULTURE DEPARTMENT (Cont)

Division A. Artistic Arrangement with a Theme

Entries will be judged on originality and creativity as well as quality of blooms.

- A1. Yesteryear - using an antique or antique-like container
- A2. Everything's Coming Up Roses - using any color roses
- A3. We're From Iowa - using corn in any form

- A4. Bless the USA - red, white and blue
- A5. As You Wish - your choice of flowers and container

Division B. - Cut Flowers

Three flowers will be judged on quality of blooms rather than container.

KITCHEN DEPARTMENT

Baked goods should be placed on a disposable plate or flat cardboard. Place in a re-closeable plastic bag with entry tag fastened outside the bag. Suggested quantity guidelines are: 1 loaf bread; 3 muffins, rolls, or biscuits, 1 pie or cake; 3-6 cookies or bars. Preserved foods exhibits must include two (2) product samples. One will be opened for evaluation. The other will be displayed and later returned to the exhibitor. Current USDA and/or Iowa State University guidelines for home food preservation methods should be used. (Check at the Extension Office for recommended practices or call the ISU Hotline at 1-800-262-3804 for current researched information.)

RULES:

1. Teams of two, ages 3 & up (must be an age differential of 10 years) Need not be related.
2. Teams must call the Henry County Extension Office (385-8126) by Friday, July 8 to register.
3. The first person on the list will be the contact person and that person is responsible for getting all of the information to the other pie baker.
4. Pies must be made evening before or same day as judging. Cannot be frozen. **No soft pies!**
5. Pies will be judged by the following categories: appearance; tenderness; texture; flavor of filling; crust; and consistency of filling.
6. Ratings for each category will be: 8 (excellent); 6 (good); 4 (fair); or 2 (poor).
7. **Presentation/display of pie will be a consideration of the judge.**
8. **Creativity of presentation counts; can be thematic, holiday, cute or beautiful.**
9. Both members of each team must be present for judging.

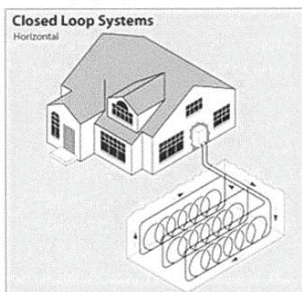
