- ⇒ Be sure each class number is filled in completely. (4 digits)
- ⇒ Read your fair book carefully to be sure you enter the right class and follow all entry rules.
- ⇒ Beef Exhibitors, please circle t-shirt size.

This form is for all **ANIMAL** classes, except horse, in the fair book **This includes: Advanced Cattle Feeder, Breeding Beef, Market Beef, Dairy, Dairy Goat, Meat Goat, Sheep, Swine, Bucket Calf, Rabbit, Chicken, Other Poultry and Dog.**

Livestock Stall, Pen or Coop Fee

Please fill this out accurately. There is limited barnspace at Mississippi Valley Fair and we need to know exact numbers. Do not order more space than the number of animals you have. Pens should accommodate four hogs, sheep or goats. We try to allow each township extra space for show equipment and feed, so you don't need to order and pay for extra space. If you order too many stalls, pens or coops, your money will not be refunded. Hobbyist Class for Showbirds in Poultry may bring your own cages. Rabbits may be put in coops from home. However, if you need a coop, please indicate on the form.

Please be sure to have your Parent/Guardian sign the statement on liability insurance.
