REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ Must be at least 16 years of age and not more than 21 years of age on August 13th, the first day of the 2009 Iowa State Fair
- ◆ Contestants must never have been married, either formally or informally, or have had children (rule applies throughout her reign as queen too)
- ◆ If chosen as Queen, you must reside in Marshall or a surrounding county during your time of reign
- ◆ All contestants must be a legal resident and citizen of the United States
- ◆ Each contestant must be an active member of at least one service organization in her community such as a church group, school organization or community group, such as 4-H or Girl Scouts
- ◆ If the 2009 Central Iowa Fair Queen cannot fulfill her duties, the first runner-up will take her place at the Iowa State Fair and/or assume all other duties as queen
