

Dear Parents and Youth,

Thank you for your interest in **Madison County 4-H Videography Club!** I'd like to take this opportunity to answer some questions you may have about the club.

When and where does Videography Club meet? During the school year, Videography Club will meet once a month, the third Thursday of the month, 4:30-6:00 pm at Madison County Extension Office. If you're not able to make every meeting, that's okay—we understand that families have busy schedules and will not require members to attend every month. Come when you're able and join the fun!

What will happen at meetings? Working in teams, club members will produce short videos. Members will have the opportunity to participate in each step of video production, from scripting and storyboarding to editing and publishing. Other club activities might include training in video production techniques, community service projects, and games or other learning opportunities.

Do I need my own camera or videography experience to become a club member? Club members are welcome to bring their own cameras to meetings—either a camcorder or a digital camera with video capabilities—but it is **not required**. Likewise, no experience is required; all you need to have is an interest in videography!

What is the membership fee? The **\$30.00** membership fee is the standard annual development fee for 4-H clubs and programs. It covers part of the cost of supplies, program development, etc. The fee is waived if a youth is already a member of 4-H. Financial assistance is also available to cover the cost of the development fee—contact our office for information regarding scholarships.

Will I be required to show at the fair? No. While you are welcomed and encouraged to complete projects for the fair, it is **not a requirement**.
