We are happy to announce that Farm Credit Services of America will be sponsoring one official exhibitor shirt per exhibitor again this year!! The official exhibitor shirt will be the required attire for exhibiting at the Boone County Fair. Club shirts and white 4-H shirts will not be worn to exhibit. All exhibitors will wear the exact same shirt. Families may choose to purchase more exhibitor shirts before county fair (NOT AT COUNTY FAIR) online through FairEntry. Extra shirts cost \$11 each and must be ordered by July 1st. Exhibitor shirts are not guaranteed for entries made after July 1st. The Free shirt and the extra shirts can be picked up with your exhibitor packet at the beginning of county fair.

Rabbit Tattooing

When: Saturday, June 3rd in the morning Where: Rabbit Building at Fairgrounds

Time: Schedule your appointment by calling Mindy Moeller at 515.230.0314.

Any rabbits needing tattooed after June 1st will be charged \$5 per rabbit. Rabbits must be tattooed by July 1 and identified in 4honline by July 1st.

Poultry Pullorum Testing

When: Friday, June 9th (evening) and Saturday, June 10th in the morning

Where: Rabbit Building at Fairgrounds

Time: Schedule your appointment by calling Kim Rhodes at 515.669.0874. **Cost:** \$3 per bird, covers cost of testing supplies and bedding for county fair.

All Birds coming to the fair have to be tested (except meat birds). Refer to the fairbook for more details.

Static Exhibits—pre-enter in fair entry by 11:59 pm on July 16th!!!

- Static Exhibits will be pre-entered this year through <u>Fair Entry</u> by 11:59 pm on July 16th.
- You will receive your completed Entry Form and Entry Tags at Check in this year. Your Entry Form and Entry Tags will be printed from the exhibits you entered in <u>Fair Entry</u> by July 16th.
- If you have a lot of exhibits and would like to pick up your Entry Tags on Monday, July 17th, you must make prior arrangements with Natalie for a July 17th pick up.
- Read your fairbook carefully (general rules, division rules and class description).
- Anyone who is enrolled in an animal project may enter a poster, video, display box, notebook, etc. related to the animal in the Animal Science Class 10110.

Often entries fit in more than one class. The appropriate class is the one that fits best with your overall goal for the exhibit.

Exhibit Write Ups

In your exhibit write up (can be written or on a CD, DVD or video tape), make sure you answer these three questions.

- 1. What did you plan to learn or do? (What was your exhibit goal(s)?)
- 2. What steps did you take to learn or do this? Explain what you did so it is easily understood. The judge wants to know and understand the steps you used to make your exhibit.
- 3. What were the most important things you learned?

Project Tip Sheets

Have you ever wondered what the judge is looking for when your Static Exhibits are being judged?

Consider participating in or coming to watch the 2023 Boone County Communications Day!

When: Monday, June 12th at 2:00 pm

Where: Extension Office

- ⇒ Educational Presentations will be given by 4th-12th grade 4-H'ers.
- ⇒ Extemporaneous Speeches will be given by senior 4-H'ers.
- ⇒ Public Speaking will be done by 4th-8th grade 4-H'ers.

Up to six presentations and two extemporaneous speakers will be selected to advance to the Iowa State Fair!

Entries are due in Fair Entry by June 5th at 11:59 pm.

Working Exhibits will be presented from 9-10 am on Friday, July 21st during fair. See the fairbook for details. Entries are due in Fair Entry by July 1st at 11:59 pm. Working Exhibits are not required to attend State Fair.

Fashion Day

Do you have an interest in clothing? Check out our Fashion Day!

- ⇒ **\$20 Challenge** purchase an outfit (top and bottom or a dress) at Goodwill, Salvation Army, or a garage sale for \$20 or less. Keep the receipt to turn in with the Clothing Event Report Form (not the Entry Form).
- ⇒ **Clothing Selection** model a purchased garment or outfit no price limit.
- ⇒ Savvy Shopper purchase a new outfit at a retail store for \$30 or less. Keep the receipts to turn in with the Clothing Report Form. (not the Entry Form)
- ⇒ **Fashion Revue -** sew a garment or outfit.
- ⇒ **Innovative Design**—encourage creativity and out of the box thinking when creating an outfit.

Enter any of the above categories by July 1st by completing an entry in <u>Fair Entry</u>. Clothing must be purchased or made by the time of entry.

Judging will occur on the morning of **Monday, July 10th** in the Fairgrounds Community Building. Participants will also practice modeling at this time.







July 1 @ 11:59 PM!!

- ⇒ 4-H livestock entries will **NOT** go through the Boone County Extension Office
- \Rightarrow All 4-H livestock exhibitors will make entries online through the State Fair Entry system
- ⇒ ALL payments, whether by check or credit card, will go directly to the State Fair Office
 - ⇒ You need to send a copy of your invoice along with your personal check if you use that payment method MAKE SURE THE TOTAL AMOUNT ON THE INCVOICE MATCHES YOUR CHECK PAYMENT!!
 - ⇒ Mail all check or cash payments directly to: Iowa State Fair, 4-H Livestock Department, P.O. Box 57130, Des Moines, IA 50317
- ⇒ Internet Explorer is not the preferred browser. Google Chrome, Firefox, and Safari are the best browsers to use when signing into FairEntry.
- ⇒ You will be required to show proof that your YQCA training has been completed prior to completing your entries. You will be asked to enter your YQCA certificate number.

The most important component to make this year's fair a success is **VOLUNTEERS!** You can volunteer one day, multiple days, or even the whole 12 days. If you come, bring a group....no one likes to travel on their own.

There are different forms for youth, adults, and evening exhibit hosts, so make sure you get the right one.

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals Training

YQCA Certification is *required* by **July 1st** for all beef, sheep, swine, dairy, goat, rabbit and poultry County & State Fair exhibitors. YQCA can be completed online.

YQCA Training is \$12/person per year. Financial Assistance is available, contact Natalie. natm@iastate.edu or 515-432-3882. YQCA is an interactive hour long training based on member's age (not grade). Youth must pass the quiz in order to get their certificate.

Certificates of Completion must be emailed, mailed or dropped off to Natalie (natm@iastate.edu) at the Extension Office as proof of training completion.


